This crucial role involves managing individual giving initiatives—such as direct mail campaigns, major gift stewardship, and annual giving—while fostering strong donor relations through meticulous gift entry and acknowledgment. The Philanthropy Manager will also provide essential strategic support to advance our development goals. We are looking for a motivated professional who excels in a collaborative environment, demonstrating a commitment to FSP's mission of inspiring our scholars to love reading and learning, believe in themselves, and create extraordinary futures. The ideal candidate will bring a blend of strategic insight and hands-on experience in development.

What You'll Do/Role Responsibilities

- 1. Donor Engagement & Stewardship:
 - Identify, cultivate and steward relationships with donors, sponsors, and partners.
 - Develop and implement strategies for donor retention and growth.
 - Prepare and distribute regular communications, including impact reports, and event invitations.
 - Maintain gifts portfolio and regularly solicit donors.
- 2. Donor Data Integrity:
 - Enter all gifts, pledges, and in-kind donations into Raiser's Edge NXT (CRM).
 - Send personalized donor acknowledgments and pledge reminders promptly.
 - Generate queries, reports, and lists as needed, and analyze data to support donor cultivation efforts.
 - Maintain the integrity of donor records by ensuring data is accurate, consistent, and complete, including entering notes and actions from FSP staff.
- 3. Team Support & Collaboration:
 - Support the Chief Development Officer in managing the Development Committee.
 - Provide additional staff support as needed to benefit FSP and expand its mission.
 - Support the Development team in grant acquisition and management.
 - Assist in the creation and execution of annual fundraising plans and FSP campaigns.
 - Represent the organization at community events.
- 4. Additional Responsibilities:
 - Perform other assigned duties.

- Bachelor's degree in nonprofit management, business administration, communications, or a related field, and a minimum of four years of related experience in fundraising.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, with a keen focus on accuracy and attention to detail.
